Cathys Story

When Cathy graduated from nursing school in 1984, she never anticipated that she would be an entrepreneur running a thriving coaching business one day. Now she speaks to other nurse entrepreneurs about how to grow their businesses. Cathy loved nursing and did not intend to leave the profession, but said yes to one opportunity after the other that presented itself, and over the past twenty-five years, has reinvented her career three times.

Her career journey took her from nursing to human resources. Returning to school for an MBA and obtaining industry certifications, Cathy built a successful career as an HR leader and ran a department until the business closed in 2016. While that was not the first time her position was eliminated, it was the one that would change the trajectory of her career.

When that job went away, Cathy took another one and was fired after just three months. A single mother with three teenage children, she felt she could not wait for her next great job to come along, so Ishe created her next great job myself; and that's how Write-Résumé-For-The-Job was born in 2017.

Early in 2018, Cathy took another HR job at a local university to provide her with a steady income and benefits while growing her business and meeting with clients in the evenings and on weekends. It was grueling.

Within the year, the business had grown to where she was working two full-time jobs and she had to make the decision to stay at her HR job or take a leap of faith and venture out on her own. Not only did Cathy leave her day job, but left four years of full tuition on the table as her daughter was an incoming freshman at that university. Leaving the job was not nearly as nerve-wracking as leaving the tuition benefit. Her daughter got scholarships and student loans to fill the gap and learned that she was capable of relying on her ambition and creativity as well, #girlpower.

A few months after leaving that job, Cathy purchased Inspire Careers, rebranded her original business, and has worked under the Inspire Careers banner ever since. In less than five years, she has supported the career advancement of professionals and executives from some of the world's most high-profile companies and has created the only new college graduate success program of its type in the country, the Inspire Careers Student Professional Launch Program<sup>™</sup>.
