Going into the program, I had expected a crash course on how the job market tends to function, and how to make my applications look generally more appealing. All said and done, I received that and more, with a greater understanding of how to expand my network and build a career.

Originally, I signed up for this program as a logical extension of graduating as a student with little experience. Leaving college, I felt particularly unprepared for what the working world had in store for me, so a more structured experience felt appropriate.

How do you feel the strategies you learned will help you as you continue in your career?

The strategies I feel will be most helpful are largely ones I didn't anticipate to learn going into the program: network management. Properly communicating and leveraging people in my network feels a lot more like a natural extension of a professional-social life, instead of something vague.

How did you feel your résumé compares with other résumés you have seen?

Comparing resumes against each other feels difficult as it seems to be a dynamic construction depending on what you're trying to advertise yourself as or accomplish. However, I felt for resumes of my sort, it was exceptional. Formatting was easy to digest while remaining descriptive, descriptions were to the point and illustrative. Nothing over the top, but effective.
