Why did you agree to have Brian participate in this program originally and were your original expectations met? The tech slowdown after the pandemic, especially at entry levels, which recovered more slowly, meant that employers and recruiters had staggering numbers of applicants for relatively few position. This forced them to eliminate applicants from the running for some pretty arbitrary reasons. The key was to catch their attention. Even someone well versed in web development such as Brian does not know all the important ways tech connects people and jobs. There's an entirely new skill set that I never used in my youth, going well beyond regular resume tweaking (although the latter is stil important in showing the relevancy of your experience to the requirements of a given position and is something Cathy excels in.) You have to match your resume, the links inside it, and the stated expectations of job posts in order to connect effectively with employers and recruiters. Cathy is very sophisticated in how that works. Cathy is also very helpful in time management with her spreadsheets that help you track your progress and not duplicate efforts needlessly. This is crucial when you are having to send vast numbers of applications, study (which you must as tech interview are written or oral exams with many stages), and follow up properly with each contact.				
How did you feel Brian's résumé compares with other résumés you have seen? Although tech is generally more flexible about focusing on what you know more than what you've done, still if, like Brian, you have missed that "internship to first job" pipeline for any reason — transferring colleges, pandemic, etc. you are still shut out to a degree.
